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ПЕРЕДМОВА

Інтернаціоналізація суспільного життя спонукає фахівців у галузі управління та адміністрування вивчати іноземну мову. Вона детермінує соціально-економічний, науково-технічний загальнокультурний прогрес суспільства. Усе це підвищує статус іноземної мови в галузі знань 07 Управління та адміністрування спеціальності 073 Менеджмент, адже держава потребує компетентних фахівців із достатнім рівнем знань з іноземної мови, професіоналів, зданих абсорбувати новий та прогресивний досвід, готових до генерування та запровадження оригінальних ідей, а також до активної міжнародної співпраці та формування кращого ставлення до України на світовій арені.

До основних перешкод здійсненню успішної інтернаціоналізації ЗВО можна віднести недостатній обсяг інформації, фінансування, відмінності в організації навчального процесу та навчальних планах, але найбільшою перепоною вважають мовний бар'єр.

Дисципліна «Іноземна мова» призначена для здобувачів вищої освіти першого (бакалаврського) рівня за спеціальністю 073 Менеджмент. Для успішної конкуренції на національному й міжнародному ринках праці, вирішення практичних проблеми і спеціалізованих завдань щодо управління організаціями та їх підрозділами на основі набутих компетентностей, здобувачі повинні на високому рівні володіти іноземною мовою.

Вивчення іноземної мови ϵ необхідною і невід'ємною складовою загальноосвітньої професійної підготовки. частиною Це зумовлено інтернаціоналізацією професійно-орієнтованого спілкування, розвитком співпраці фахівців на глобальному рівні і розширенням сфери управління та адміністрування. Тому при вивченні іноземної мови пріоритетним ϵ знання структур і стратегій фахового дискурсу, форм і засобів комунікації, а також вміння ними оперувати. Курс вивчення іноземної мови має професійноорієнтований і комунікативний характер, а дисципліна спрямована на оволодіння практичними мовними навичками та фундаментальними знаннями з управління діяльністю.

МЕТА ТА ЗАВДАННЯ НАВЧАЛЬНОЇ ДИСЦИПЛІНИ

Метою вивчення навчальної дисципліни «Іноземна мова» є досягнення належного рівня знань, навичок і вмінь, який забезпечує необхідну для здобувачів вищої освіти комунікативну самостійність у сферах професійного, академічного й ситуативно-побутового спілкування в усній та письмовій формах.

Завдання дисципліни передбачають опанування теоретичної практичної підготовки. Теоретична підготовка полягає в розширенні словникового запасу, закріпленні знань з граматики; оволодінні правильною вимовою фахових термінів; навчанні здобувачів вищої освіти будувати речення з усіма існуючими в іноземній мові граматичними структурами, розуміти зміст та оригінальність професійно-орієнтованого аутентичного тексту; вивченні мовленнєвих зразків, які ϵ характерними для діалогічного й монологічного мовлення. Практична підготовка передбачає формування вміння здобувачів вищої освіти будувати самостійні висловлювання іноземною мовою правильному граматичному й інтонаційному оформленні, вести бесіду на будь-яку з пройдених тем, висловлювати своє враження, думку, робити повідомлення, готувати доповіді, презентації (згідно з тематикою занять). Під час вивчення курсу здобувачі вищої освіти повинні вміти самостійно виявляти толерантність, відповідальність, високий рівень культури на основі здатності розуміти інших, гнучкості мовних і засобів, некатегоріальних невербальних суджень, уміння позитивно взаємодіяти з представниками інших культур у контексті діалогу культур. Завданнями дисципліни, що забезпечують досягнення поставленої мети, ϵ набуття та розвиток відповідних знань і вмінь.
